
*Note: When installed with a fresh air kit, the stove must be anchored to the floor (see **Step 12**). Use appropriate anchoring with regards to your installation.

**Note: To connect to the outside, use a 5-inches diameter insulated flexible pipe (J). This HVAC type pipe must conform to ULC S110 and/or UL 181 standards and must withstand temperatures up to 250 °F.


